NEW REPORT RELEASED FROM ME-MIND PROJECT



The Creative Europe funded project has made great progress with the publication of [The Guidelines report – Data and Impact. Guidelines on how data helps to understand the impact of the CCIs](#). 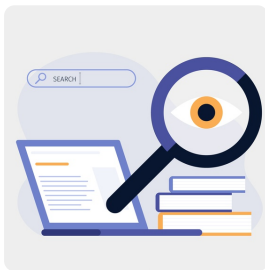
